

Report for Webinar on The Islamic Finance

The webinar on “The Future of Islamic Finance” was organised by Human Welfare League and Honoris Educational Network in Mauritius. Our guest speaker was Dr. Salma Sairally, Consultant , International Shariah Research Academy for Islamic Finance. (ISRA)

Brief of the Webinar

The session started with the definition of the subject, highlighting the fundamental different with other system. The speaker, with several examples, explained the implication and reality of an Islamic Finance bank. The focus was on the opportunities, what is the future trend and field in which Islamic Finance will play a major. The historic growth of Islamic Finance and new products like Sukuk and other products was explained and emphasis was laid on ethical and environmental consideration for investment to the future of Blue economy.

The question-and-answer session was very fruitful with several question based on the situation of Islamic Finance and bank in Mauritius, and how to implement Islamic Finance concept in various fields.
